Your health care provider may recommend vaccinations, also known as shots or immunizations, to help prevent certain serious illnesses. *Talk with your doctor or pharmacist about which vaccine(s) they recommended for you and schedule accordingly.

Information from Oakland County Health Dept. - There is a \$7 administration fee per vaccine. If you have insurance, check with your provider for possible benefit coverage. A [fee schedule](#) is available for those not eligible for state and/or federal vaccine programs. No one will be denied access to services due to inability to pay; there is a discounted/sliding fee schedule available. Vaccine payment options include cash, credit (Visa/Mastercard), Medicare, Medicaid, most Blue Cross Blue Shield plans, and additional insurances. Some of the benefits include stress reduction, improved sleep, pain reduction, mental clarity, increased circulation and flexibility, and an overall sense of peace and tranquility.

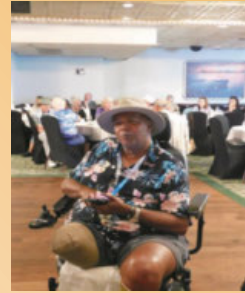
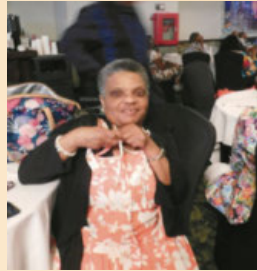

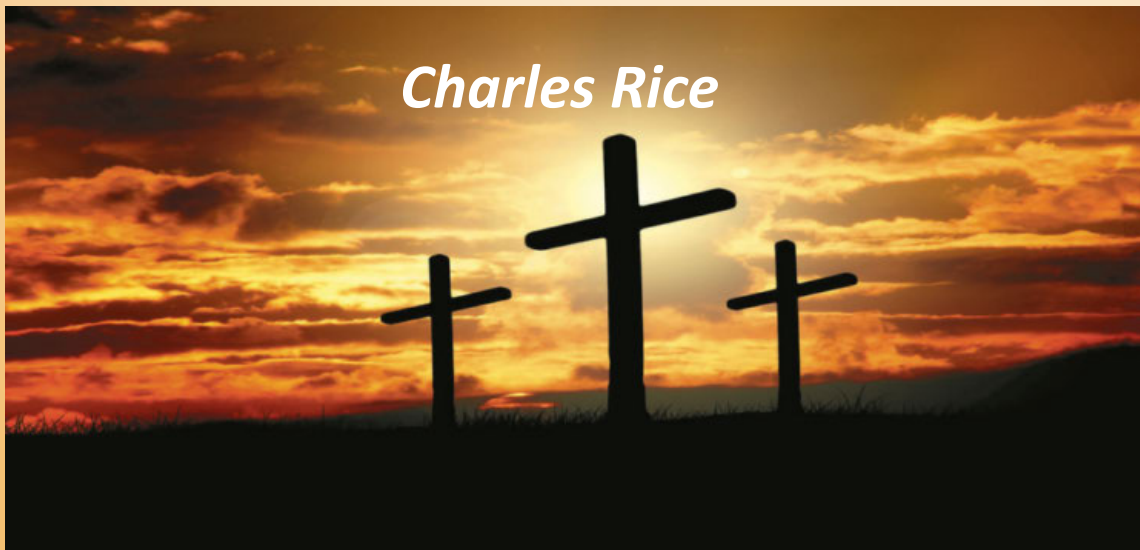
